	Camera with charger for batteries, extra batteries	
	Extra memory cards	
	Binoculars	
	Small flashlight	
	Prescription and personal medication	
	Insect repellent	
	Malaria Prophylactics when visiting Zimbabwe, Zambezi region & Etosha National Park	
	Toiletries	
	Sun block, at least Factor 40	
	Lip ice and sunglasses	
	Hat for protection against the sun	
	Comfortable clothes for at least 4 days	
	Windproof jacket to wear on game drives	
	For winter, clothes that can be worn in layers	
	Shoes that will be comfortable for walking	
	Flip-flops	

ALSO CONSIDER:

- Anti-mosquito wrist bands – you will even be able to trade with it!
- Waterproof bag to keep your passport in
- Couple of \$1 and \$5 bills for tips
- Keep in mind that visitors from the USA do need a VISA for Zimbabwe
- No need to apply before-hand, since it can be bought upon arrival at the airport or border post. Have \$40 ready, since no change is given.
- No VISA is needed for Namibia or Botswana
- The currency that is used at Vic Falls in Zimbabwe is US \$.
- No need to try to obtain any SA Rand or Namibian dollar in the USA but rather exchange your US \$ in Namibia or Botswana.
